March - A Month of Change

March, a month of change, a month of opportunities! What a winter here in the great white north! Ice fishing by New Years, ice disappearing by mid month, then back to the deep freeze. That makes predicting fishing in March interesting to say the least.

Spring officially arrives March 20th but most years there is an open water much earlier.

Lake Michigan perch, trout and salmon would be a great place to start if the winds cooperate. Want something warmer? Cooling lakes, Braidwood and LaSalle open in March. Those fish haven't seen a fisherman in six months. Be careful though as even a moderate wind can make these lakes dangerous for small boats. All the local rivers will have Walleye or Sauger eager to bite as they recover from spawning. This is a great time to target local ponds and lakes for every type of fish. Target the shallow north shore lines, lay downs and sea walls, as these areas heat up first. The late afternoon bite can be great!

One last tip. Make sure your gear is in the best condition possible. Especially the reel drags, rod guides and if you are using mono from last year replace at least the first hundred feet. If using braid check for frayed line and cut back.

Looking forward to another great year of fishing! See you on the water! Next month - we have a fishing tackle (and outdoors equipment) SWAP MEET!
