Relax, Sit a Spell - August Fishing

In these days of remote controlled electric motors, modern outboards and electronics that side scan, down scan and forward scan, I think we can become to focused on the gadgets and not the fish. With a spring and summer of intense fishing pressure I think we need to take a deep breath and sit awhile to improve our catch. We don't think about all the noise we are making below the water. On hot August days taking is easy can result in some great catches. While wading last summer I was very frustrated on my lack of success. I took a break, sat on a flat rock and just watched the water flowing by. To my surprise a group of Smallmouth Bass showed up, almost at my feet! They willingly hit my crankbait. At Lake Sara, club members Chuck and Sue Lee make great catches from a shore while everyone else is running up and down the lake with mixed results. My suggestion for August is to find a likely spot, shut down everything but your eyes and ears. Sit, observe, and wait a bit. The fish will often reveal themselves with a spray of minnows, popping sounds in the pads and swirls along a rocky shore. Keep your presentations simple, live bait, a wacky rigged or Ned rigged worm, small crank baits and artificial frogs. Enjoy your surroundings and appreciate what nature gives you! Summer is almost over, don't forget to take a kid fishing.
