The Heat is On - July Fishing

July, it's usually the hottest month of the year. The days are still long and often the nights remain warm and humid. I think the fish do the same thing we do, get up early, eat and as it gets hot they seek shelter until the sun starts to get low in the sky and grab another bite to eat. Warm water increases their metabolism but also holds less oxygen, so the fish have to find cooler, well oxygenated water. On rivers like the Fox and Kankakee this often means fishing by riffles or shade producing lay downs or overhanging trees. Lakes can be tough.

Thermoclines may eliminate oxygen in deeper water. This can force fish to seek cover in the shallows. Docks, weed edges and thick mats of lily pads and grass often hold some great fish. Drop shoting wacky worms along deep weed edges and weedless frogs in the pads are two of my favorite presentations. Night fishing with dark, noisy lures can be exciting but be safe, things go bump in the dark!

Don't forget Lake Michigan! Perch season has reopened and jumbo perch at sunrise on soft shell crawfish can be great fun and provide great meals. July is a great month for Salmon and Trout on Lake Michigan. Steelhead often feed near the surface and fight like little missiles, King Salmon are eating voraciously and many will be over thirty pounds this year. Plus, it's cooler by the lake!
